

2020/2021 TAMPA BAY DOWNS STALL APPLICATION

NOVEMBER 25 TO MAY 2

*Apply only for the amount of stalls you can readily fill

-ATTENTION TRAINERS-

1. Stalls must be stripped prior to leaving, or you will be subject to a \$20.00 per stall cleaning fee. All stalls must have front stall mats NO exceptions. Bagged shavings to be used ONLY, per EPA regulations.
2. No more than twenty-five percent (25%) of any stable's horses may be Maidens. This ratio must be maintained the entire meeting!
3. Six-year-old maidens and older with more than ten starts may not start at the meeting, unless approved by the Racing Secretary.
4. This application will not be considered unless all items are properly completed; the reverse side is signed by the applicant; and it is received NO LATER than SEPTEMBER 30, 2020. A copy of VALID WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION MUST BE ATTACHED.
5. Barn area opens for horses October 28, 2020. Ship in between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. only, except for special arrangement with Racing Secretary.
6. First day of training will be November 4, 2020.
7. Foals of 2019 will not be permitted on the grounds.
8. Pony stalls allotted for stables of 25 or more only.
9. No stalls are to be used as feed rooms. Trainers are allotted one tack room per five stalls with a non-refundable \$25 key charge. Additional rooms (Pods) available with a \$300 refundable damage deposit and an additional \$200 per month.
10. A current paper Coggins report must be attached to a horse's foal certificate or the entry will not be accepted.
11. No washing machines will be allowed in the Barn Area per EPA regulations.
12. ALL TRAINERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR EMPLOYEES CONDUCT - FAILURE TO FOLLOW RULES AND/OR GUIDELINES WILL RESULT IN FINES AND/OR LOSS OF STALLS.
13. Please be aware that Tampa Bay Downs will follow all CDC and AAEP recommendations regarding the health and safety of all participants throughout the season. Please check Tampa Bay Downs Social Media pages or watch for TEXT alerts for the latest protocol.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Stalls are allotted solely as an accommodation to owners and trainers in order to encourage full fields at Tampa Bay Downs, which by the allocation of stalls expects the full participation of the applicant for the duration of the 2020-2021 Race Meeting. Lack of participation or early departure may result in a reduction of stall allocation for future race meetings. Any claimed horses need to fit into your allotment.

Tampa Bay Downs reserves the right to conduct out-of-competition testing on all horses stabled on the grounds of the association. There will be no dogs or wildlife of any kind including, but not limited to, birds, chickens, roosters or winged animals on the premises. Equine companion animals must share a stall with an approved Thoroughbred.

TAKE NOTE: All horsemen must be in good financial standing with all backside vendors and the Association to be considered in the stall application process. When shipping horses to Tampa Bay Downs, you must have a current 72 hour health certificate. All horses must be vaccinated against Equine Herpes Type 1 (EHV-1) between 14 & 120 days prior to arrival.
