Jockey William Henry won this race three times: twice (1994 and 1995) with the combination of Not Surprising, owner Robert VanWorp and trainer Judson VanWorp. In 1999, Henry rode Brisco Jack to victory for owner Martin Cherry and trainer Raymond Tamargo. Above the Wind has won this race 3 times; all three of his wins came with reinsman Frederico Mata in the irons. Mata has claimed four Pelican Stakes; his other victory came aboard Secret Romeo in 2002.
